APPEALS COMMITTEE: The Appeals Committee will consist of the President and the Chief Steward of whichever section the appeal originates. The plaintiff must lodge an appeal with the Chief Steward of the section concerned within 30 minutes of the completion of the class judging being notified. The appeal must be in writing and accompanied by \$50, which will be refunded by the Secretary if the appeal is upheld.

THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS APPLY TO ALL CATTLE SECTIONS

- All Beef, Dairy and Led Steer entries to be submitted by post or email to Show Secretary by 5th May 2017
- No cattle will be allowed on the grounds unless the herd health status declaration has been completed and returned with the entry form.
- All exhibitors must have paper work for NLIS along with National Vendor Declaration and Way Bill, available immediately upon request by stewards.
- All animals must be registered and subjected to inspection for identification by an official inspector. Led Steers are not required to be a registered animal.
- All cattle to be exhibited must be in the Showground by 7:30am, Saturday 20th May
- Judging will commence at 8:00am for Beef Section and 9:00am for Dairy Section. All stock must be led into the ring to be judged
- If in the opinion of a qualified Veterinary Surgeon appointed by the Society, an animal on the Showground is affected by sickness, disease or other ailment, as to warrant removal from the ground, the exhibitor shall remove such animal.
- Prize winners MUST remain and parade in the "Bellingen Solar Depot" Grand Parade at 2:00pm. Exhibitors to assemble at 1:45pm.
- Prize money will be issued with ribbons after each class is judged.
