Conditions of Entry

1. All entries must be the work of the exhibitor, completed in the last two (2) years and not previously exhibited in any Bellingen competition.
2. There is a limit of four(4) entries per exhibitor in total with a maximum of two (2) per section.
3. Size limits: Hanging work maximum 6000 cm². 3D/Sculpture work maximum 20 kilograms, freestanding.
4. Hanging work must be ready to hang with a cord. Canvases must be framed or finished and all other surfaces must be framed. All works must be clearly marked on the back with Name of Artist, Class, Title, Medium, Price or NFS (not for sale). 3D/ Sculpture works must be labeled on the base with same information.
5. Entry fees: \$15 Adults and \$5 children
6. All sales have a commission of 25% deducted by the Bellingen River Agricultural Society Ltd.
7. Should any dispute arise for which no specific rule is laid down, the Committee's decision is final.
8. Software-produced print media, china painting and folk art are ineligible for any class.
9. Exhibits that are not for sale are ineligible for the Bellingen Shire Council Acquisitive Art Award.
10. Professional artists (those with an ABN for art sales) are ineligible for the Bellingen Shire Council Acquisitive Art Award. Only amateur artists are eligible for this award.
11. The committee will take all care with exhibits but accepts no responsibility for loss or damage.
12. All exhibits will be displayed if possible but the committee reserves the right to reject any entry.
13. The Judge's decision is final.
