Conditions of Entry

1. All entries must be the work of the exhibitor, completed in the last two (2) years and not previously exhibited in any Bellinghen competition.
2. There is a limit of four (4) entries per exhibitor in total with a maximum of two (2) per section.
3. Size limits: 2D: work maximum size 6000 cm². 3D/sculpture work maximum 20 kilograms, must be free standing.
4. Hanging work must be ready to hang with a cord. Canvases must be framed or finished and all other surfaces must be framed. All works must be clearly marked on the back with Name of Artist, Class, Title, Medium, Price or NFS (not for sale). 3D /Sculpture works must be labelled on the base with same information.
5. Entry Fees: \$15 Adults & \$10 Children (12-18 yrs).
6. Artists under 12 years of age, are not eligible.
7. The judge will take into consideration when judging, artworks created by artists aged between 12 and 18 years.
8. All sales have a 25% commission deducted by the Bellinger River Agricultural Society Ltd.
9. Should any dispute arise for which no specific rule is laid down, the Committee's decision is final.
10. Software-produced print media, china painting and folk art are ineligible for any class.
11. The Committee will take all care with exhibits but accepts no responsibility for loss or damage.
12. All exhibits will be displayed if possible but the Committee reserves the right to reject any entry.
13. The Judge's decision is final.
14. Winning entries will be listed on the Shows website after the official opening on 9 May 2020.
