2. All Beef, Led Steer & Heifer entries to be submitted by post or email to the Bellingen Show Secretary by **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> May, 2023**.
3. All exhibitors must have paperwork for NLIS along with National Vendor Declaration and Waybill, available immediately upon request by stewards.
4. All animals must be registered and subjected to inspection of identification by an official inspector. Led Steers & Heifers are not required to be registered animals.
5. Cattle for the **Led Steer & Heifer competition** to be in the showground for weigh in by **8.00am Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> May, 2023**.
6. **Beef cattle** to be exhibited and exhibitors must be in the Showground by **7.30am Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> May, 2023**.
7. All stock must be led into the ring to be judged. **Leading exhibitors must be 12 years of age or over.**
8. If, in the opinion of a qualified Veterinary Surgeon appointed by the Bellinger River Agricultural Society, an animal on the Showground is affected by sickness, disease or other ailment, as to warrant removal from the ground, the exhibitor shall remove such animal.
